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How can Angola increase its power generation capacity?

Angola is working hard to increase its power generation capacity by boosting hydro and solar energy, as well as linking and expanding its electric grids. This will create more sustainable income sources, promote the global energy transition, increase the country's exports and modernise the economic possibilities of its citizens.

What percentage of Angola is electrified by network extension?

The electrification of Angola through network extension may include up to to 93% of the population, 100% of municipalities and 70% of communes (about 391). The majority of the provinces with the exception of Cunene, Uige and Malange, would obtain a grid connection rate of around 90%, as shown

Can Angola produce electricity from mini-hydro power stations?

Furthermore, Angola's Ministry of Energy and Water has identified nearly 100 locations to produce up to 600 MW of renewable electricity from mini-hydro power stations - which will each have a capacity of less than 10 MW - throughout the country's vast river network.
