Wait for Creation: Once you run the command, Distrobox will pull the image and set up the container. This process takes a few moments or longer if your internet speed is slow. This command drops you into a shell inside your new container. Perform Basic Setup: Update the new container, install essential packages, or configure custom software.

Is distrobox a container manager?

Distrobox itself is not a container manager and relies on Podman or Docker to create containers. From the Distrobox documentation: Use any Linux distribution inside your terminal. Enable both backward and forward compatibility with software and freedom to use whatever distribution you're more comfortable with.

How to install distrobox?

There is a prerequisite for installing Distrobox. That is, you must have either podman or docker installed. If you have a relatively modern Linux distribution, I recommend installing podman from your software repositories. Otherwise, install docker and follow the steps mentioned below.

How to Port a distrobox container to a host system?

In case you have an application inside the Distrobox container that you would like to port to the host system, you can do so using the distrobox-export command. But first, access the container's shell. Here, we are going to install Flameshot which is a free and open-source cross-platform tool for taking screenshots.
