

Title: London non-storage projects

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Is London a safe and secure environment?

It is essential that London develops as a safe and secure environment that is resilient against fire impacts. For new developments including refurbishments, strategies to maximise building resilience and minimise physical risk of fires and related hazards must be considered at the beginning of the design process.

What is the East London Link Phase 4 project?

The City of London will reconstruct Oxford Street from Highbury Avenue to a few metres east of Second Street as part of the East London Link Phase 4 project. The project will add dedicated transit lanes and other rapid transit infrastructure on Oxford Street while addressing underground needs.

Can the UK unlock its storage capacity for cross-border CO₂ volumes?

Unlocking the UK's storage capacity for cross-border CO₂ volumes also has the potential to mutually benefit the UK and its regional partners (e.g. EU Member States), our economies and our CCUS sectors. NPT in the CCUS context is the transportation of CO₂ using road, rail, barge, and/or shipping.

What is London's 'renew construction' program?

From new roads and bike lanes to enhanced transit facilities and underground infrastructure, London's Renew Construction Program is helping shape the way we move while encouraging cleaner, emissions-free travel and making our city more sustainable for the generations to come.

Should Europe cooperate in CO₂ transport & storage?

The European Union's Industrial Carbon Management Strategy [footnote 31] shares the view that there are clear opportunities to cooperate across borders with regards to CO₂ transport and storage.

Why should the UK invest in CO₂ storage appraisal?

It is important that the UK has the right regulatory frameworks in place and a commercial landscape conducive to driving investment in CO₂ storage appraisal and in the necessary supporting infrastructure.
