Widespread Network but Moderate Power: Western European countries, including the Netherlands, Germany, and France, show a balanced approach with a widespread network of charging points. Although their recharging power per point is moderate, their extensive network supports a large EV fleet, ensuring accessibility and convenience for users.

Should Eastern European countries focus on high-power charging points?

High-Power Charging Focus: Eastern European countries demonstrate the effectiveness of focusing on high-power charging points. This strategy can be beneficial for regions with lower overall EV adoption but needing efficient and quick charging solutions.

Does the EU have a common plug standard for charging electric vehicles?

VII We found that the Commission has succeeded in promoting a common EU plug standard for charging electric vehicles, and that users are gradually gaining more harmonised access to different charging networks. However, obstacles to travel across the EU in electric vehicles remain.

Does EU funding support interoperable charging stations?

VIII EU financial support from the Connecting Europe Facility has been used widely to promote the deployment of interoperable charging stations across the EU. However, in the absence of a comprehensive infrastructure gap analysis, the Commission has been unable to ensure that EU funding goes where it is most needed.

There are substantial differences between Member States, with the highest density in the western and the lowest in central and eastern European countries. In the EU-27, Germany, France, and Netherlands together account for a large majority (69 %) of all charging points.
